

## **North Elementary Continuous Learning Plan**

<u>Continuous Learning Focus</u> - Attached is a list of skills, standards, and topics that each grade has left to master for the 2019-2020 school year. Only a few of the skills are new concepts to students. The majority of the material has already been taught, but may need review in order to attain mastery. These lists of skills will be our focus for the next 6 weeks of instruction.

Weekly Learning Menus - Menus will be delivered on Sunday afternoons, for the following week. They will include all subjects, skills/standards, links to instruction, activities, directions for turning things in, etc. for that grade level. There will be at least 6 activities per subject with a few PE, Music, Art, & Keyboarding activities included. The expectation is for students to complete at least 3 activities per subject per week for minimal participation. Menus will provide most everything parents & students need for the week, all in one place. They will be sent out via Dojo and School Messenger email and will also be posted to our School Website. Parents will need to initial off on all activities their student completes that week and return a copy or picture of the sign off sheet to the homeroom teacher by the following Sunday.

<u>Weekly Intro & Wrap Up Videos</u> - Teachers will send out weekly introduction and wrap up videos on Mondays and Fridays via dojo. These videos will introduce and explain the learning menu for the week and wrap up with any extra information needed on Fridays.

<u>Weekly Zoom Meetings</u> - Parents will sign students up for a Small Group (6 or less) Student/Teacher Weekly Zoom Meeting. Homeroom teachers will host these meetings on Tuesdays or Wednesdays and use them to go over the learning menu, expand on instructions & expectations, answer questions, and connect personally to students as much as possible.

<u>Parent/Teacher Contact</u> - Teachers will directly contact each student's parent at least once a week to check on progress of any students who were unable to connect on Zoom, were unable to work digitally, or have not shown proof of any active participation that week.

Open Office Hours - Teachers will be available to answer questions via dojo or e-mail between the hours of 7:30am-3pm M-F. Many will be setting some evening hours as well and will communicate those to parents (evening response times may not be as quick as during normal school hours). Teachers will also continue to push out re-teach videos or resources as the week goes on based on student questions, struggles, and clarification needs.

<u>Special Education</u> - Students on IEPs will continue to work towards their goals and will participate in Continuous Learning with their peers. Adapted Learning Menus will be sent to those who need them. Additional Zoom meetings will be scheduled weekly with Special Education staff to provide accommodations and supplementary support to those students.

- \*www.istation.com is one of the Reading & Math programs that may be an option for your student's learning activities each week. This is a program we use weekly, if not daily, at school. Each student should know their login. If not please send their teacher a message on Class Dojo. \*\*When they first log in, it will ask you to agree to terms. You will then have to click the "Download IStation" button and choose which platform you will be using. There are also pdf technical guides out beside each platform to help walk you through downloading the program. If given the choice, you will choose to "install" or "download" then if asked, choose "default" and then type in our domain berryhillsouth.berryhill.ok Once the program or app is downloaded, you should see it on your desktop. If not, you can search for it in the startup menu, then right click and chose create a shortcut. Always make sure our domain "berryhillsouth.berryhill.ok" shows up above the username and password boxes on the login screen. Feel free to dojo teachers if you have questions or need help.
