

South Elementary Continuous Learning Plan

<u>Weekly Learning Menus</u> - Menus will be delivered on Sunday afternoons, for the following week. They will include all subjects, skills/standards, links to instruction, activities, and directions for turning things in, etc. for that grade level. There will be at least 6 activities per subject with a few PE, Music, and Art activities included. We are asking that you complete 4 out of the 6 activities under the Reading and Math columns. The following columns are for enrichment, but will benefit your child's learning at this time. Menus will provide most everything parents & students need for the week, all in one place. They will be sent out via Dojo and School Messenger email and will also be posted to our School Website. Parents will need to initial off on all activities their student completes that week and return a copy or picture of the sign off sheet to the homeroom teacher by the following Sunday.

<u>Positive Teacher/Student Interaction</u> - Teachers will do a video at least once daily where students will be able to see the teacher and hear their voice. This may be presented as a Morning Meeting, reading a book, presentation of a lesson, etc. Teachers may also choose to conduct Zoom meetings with individual students or whole class zooms.

<u>Parent/Teacher Contact</u> - Teachers will direct message each student's parent at least once a week to check on progress of students and any concerns parents may have.

<u>Open Office Hours</u> - Teachers will be available to answer questions via dojo or e-mail between the hours of 7:30am-3pm M-F. Many will be setting some evening hours as well and will communicate those to parents (evening response times may not be as quick as during normal school hours). Teachers will also continue to push out re-teach videos or resources as the week goes on based on student questions, struggles, and clarification needs.

<u>Special Education</u> - Students on IEPs will continue to work towards their goals and will participate in Continuous Learning with their peers. Special Education teachers will consult with classroom teachers and contact parents with any modifications that need to be made to the weekly Learning Menus.
